



We are a small animal shelter in the heart of the Riviera Maya and have been running officially as the Peanut Pet Shelter for almost two years.

To date we have rescued and re-homed around 350 dogs and cats and currently have over 75 animals presently at the shelter.

We run totally on donations, both financial and medical and at this moment in time are in very desperate need of antibiotics to combat the tick borne disease Ehrlichiosis.

There has always been a huge problem in the area with ticks and none of the regular treatments such as Frontline seem to help diminish this. We regularly fumigate which does seem to help but with so many different varieties of ticks we cannot seem to get rid of them, which sadly, at the moment, means we are fighting a losing battle against Ehrlichiosis.

As you are aware, the most effective antibiotic treatment is Doxycycline and we are now treating the diagnosed animals with it. With so many animals it is totally cost prohibitive for us to treat all the animals in the shelter and maintain our current basic operating budget.

If you have any out of date Doxycycline or samples that you do not have a use for it would be an invaluable help if you would consider donating these to Peanut Pet Shelter.

Sadly, we have already lost a number of young dogs to this dreadful disease and want to do everything in our power to ensure no further losses.
